Brighten somebody's day with this bold floral greeting

Although it's easy to keep in touch on the phone or online, you just can't bet the thrill of receiving a handmade greeting in the post. This lovely design by Tracy Daykin-Jones is perfect for sending 'just because'. Featuring brightly patterned papers and alphabet thickers, it can be put together in a matter of minutes!

#### We used...

\* Card, white \* Papers, American Crafts, Shimelle Never Grow Up 12" x 12" pad \* Embellishments, American Crafts, Shimelle Never Grow Up, Here We \* Go foam thickers \* Punch, corner rounder \* Adhesives

Mount green wavy paper onto a sidefolding blank. Trim floral paper slightly smaller and round off the corners.

2 Snip a rectangle from pink and cut into a pennant at one end. Spell 'Hello' in alphabet thickers and fix to the strip.

Score and fold the left-hand edge of the strip, then secure the flap to the reverse of the floral panel. Fix to the greeting with foam pads to finish. **(**
